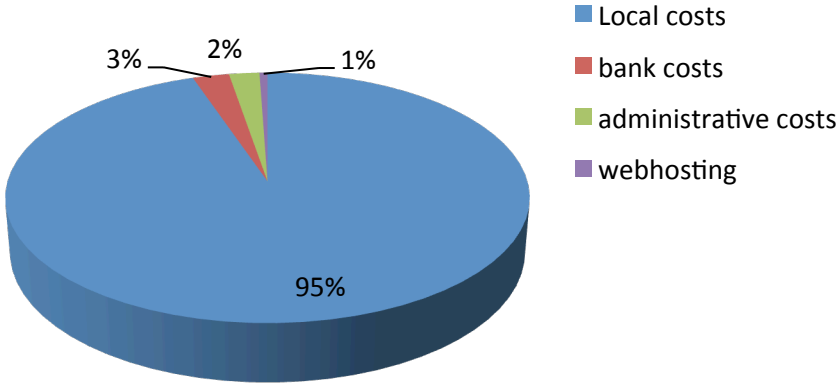


Financial overview Anan Clinica 2014

We are very proud that Anan facilitated Anan projects of eight students in 2014. The health projects of the medical students have had a focus on family topics (e.g. mother & child, family planning, HIV and hygiene). A finance student carried out one project. She gave training to the people in the village on how to organize your income. The students carried out the projects in Nanatha together with the Activistas and Anan’s local project manager Feliciano. In 2014 the group of activistas expanded with two from 12 in January to 14 in December. The activistas receive a monthly allowance of 425 MZN per month (per December 2014) and they receive a lunch. Anan Clinica employs Feliciano.

In line with previous years, we managed in 2014 to keep the administrative, bank and IT cost at a minimum. 95% of the total expenses are local costs. Local costs entail the salary of the local project manager Feliciano, the costs for running our activistas program and costs that are made by the students to run their projects. In 2014 we also bought several bikes to allow the activistas to reach more villages in the surroundings of Nanatha. Moreover, money was spent on more latrinas in the village and maintenance on the roof of the Anan Clinica office in Nanatha.
